PRE-K & KINDERGARTEN ENROLLMENT FOR NEXT SCHOOL YEAR SCHEDULED
TUESDAY, MARCH 27 & WEDNESDAY, MARCH 28, 2018

Enrollment for Pre-K & Kindergarten students ***NEW*** to the Blanchard School district has been scheduled for March 27th & 28th. Students who will be 4 years old on or before September 1, 2018 are eligible to enroll in the Pre-K program and students who will be 5 years old on or before September 1, 2018 are eligible to enroll in Kindergarten. You may enroll your child on either day.

If you are planning to send your child to Pre-K, it is imperative that you enroll them on one of these days. The number of Pre-K classes will be determined based on the amount of students enrolled on March 27th and 28th. Anyone who enrolls after this date will be placed on a waiting list.

Enrollment will be held at Blanchard Elementary School, 1620 N Main. Parents are asked to enter through the double glass doors in the front of the building. There will be a table set up in the lobby to assist you. Hours of enrollment will be 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. each day. (***Enrollment can be a lengthy process; students DO NOT have to attend.***)

THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE REQUIRED FOR PRE-K AND KINDERGARTEN STUDENT ENROLLMENT:

- * **Copy of Certified Birth Certificate** (*hospital copy is not acceptable*)
- * **Proof of Residency** (*current utility bill, lease agreement, warranty deed, ad valorem statement, mortgage statement or homestead exemption statement or similar legal document, which shows the physical address of the home and is current within the past 45 days.*)
- * **Immunization Record** (*must be up-to-date for child's current age*)

Pre-K Immunization Requirements:

- 4 DTaP
 - 3 Polio
 - 1 MMR
 - 3 Hepatitis B (takes 6 months to complete)
 - 2 Hepatitis A (takes 6 months to complete)
 - Varicella (or statement noting child has had chicken pox)
- (Verification of immunizations is needed prior to student being placed in a class.)***

Kindergarten Immunization Requirements:

- 5 DTaP (4 accepted if the 3rd dose was given after age 4)
 - 4 Polio (3 accepted if the 3rd dose was given after age 4)
 - 2 MMR
 - 3 Hepatitis B (takes 6 months to complete)
 - 2 Hepatitis A (takes 6 months to complete)
 - Varicella (or statement noting child has had chicken pox)
- (Verification of immunizations is needed prior to student being placed in a class.)***
